Guidance News for Seniors

Senior year is full of little details that can often make one feel overwhelmed, stressed, and/or cause a great deal of worry for families. Rest assured that we have met with our Seniors and work diligently to try to keep them informed of their "to do list".

One very important task for Seniors who plan to attend college next year is completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). It is an application that must be completed every year to see if a student qualifies for any financial assistance paying for college and how much they may qualify to get. It is a form completed for federal and state government agencies; local school staff is not a part of the process nor do we see the results. Please make sure that you complete the form. You and your child need to have

your 2012 taxes figured and complete the FAFSA by March 10th to qualify for maximum aid.

The first example is the SHS Virtual School. This provides an opportunity for students that cannot attend school in a traditional format as an option. This also provides an opportunity for Adult Students that wish to earn a diploma. We feel that it is our duty to try and provide a service for our citizens that never completed High School.

The second example is the opportunity of choices in the traditional school setting. SHS has choices for students based upon learning styles between our High Schools That Work and New Tech Schools. We also provide vocational choices through Prosser School of Technology and our own dual credit EMT course through Vincennes University.

The last example is our vast AP & Dual Credit offerings. Students can graduate from SHS with over 30 hours of college credit. Our partners include Ivy Tech, Purdue and Vincennes. We are in discussions to increase that number with our partners and looking to form new partnerships.
