1. Credits may be completed by taking courses at the Credit Recovery Lab located in Room 101.
2. Courses may be taken by correspondence study and must be completed with final grades received at SHS by May 17, 2013, in order to participate in the Graduation Program.

Students who fail to meet graduation requirements are not permitted to participate in the graduation exercises. The diploma will be awarded upon completion of the required work.
