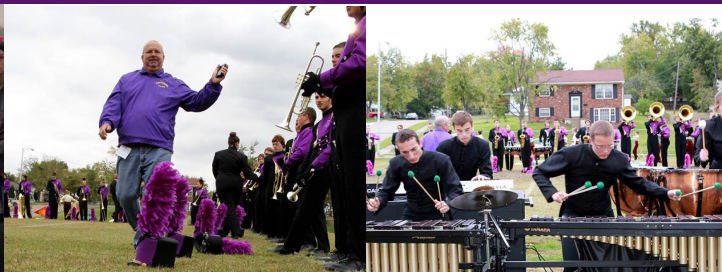

Students from Scottsburg High School's newspaper and yearbook staffs were recognized by the Indiana High School Student Press Association for exemplary work at the annual convention on Oct. 17. Both The Booster and Totem were named Hoosier Stars which is the top journalism award in the state.

In addition to top publication awards, individual students were also recognized with the Harvey Award for producing the top work in the state in their division in various categories. Winning Harvey Awards for The Booster were: Kris Shunnara for advertising and civic journalism; Logan Trowbridge for infographics, news writing and civic journalism; Hyeree Ellis for page design; Tori Rone for photojournalism portfolio and sports photo; and Michael Killey for feature photo.
