The Indiana High School Baseball Coaches Association (IHSBCA) is honoring Mr. Rabe for his outstanding career in baseball; 31 years as varsity baseball coach (6 years at Castle, 3 years at Boonville, 19 years at Jeffersonville and

3 years at Scottsburg). His teams have won 12 sectionals, 5 regionals, 2 semi-state championships and over 500 games. Mr. Rabe also served as the IHSBCA President in 2009-2010.

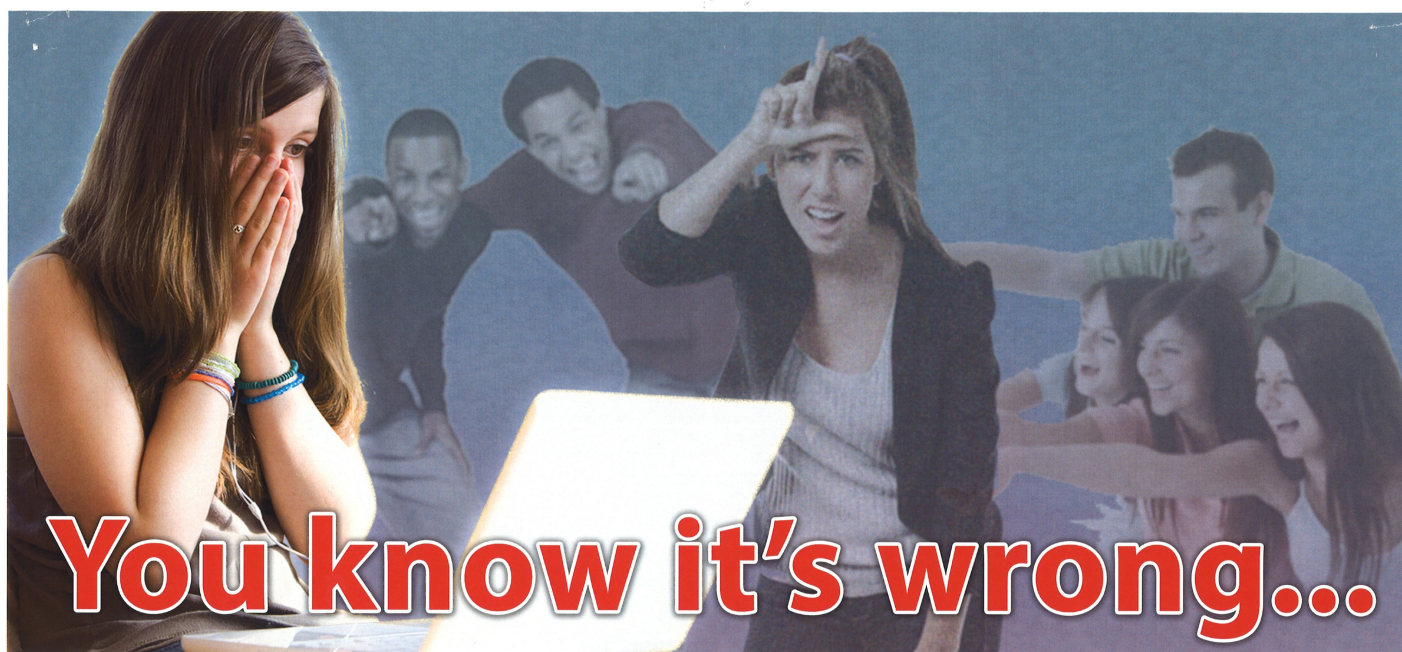
