Eight Scottsburg FFA members had the opportunity to attend the 86th National FFA Convention and Expo in Louisville, Kentucky on October 30th to November 2nd. The theme for this year's convention was *Ignite*. The convention included sessions led by the 2012-2013 National Officer Team, the FFA Mega Store, FFA Career Fair and both Educational and Career

Development tours. The National FFA Convention is for FFA chapters all over America. There were 55,000+ members who attended convention this year.
