## **SCOTTSBURG FFA STAYS BUSY**

Scottsburg FFA members have been staying busy by competing in contests and attending different events. The Scottsburg FFA is 62 members strong. In October, nine members attended the Area II Soils Judging contest in Bedford, Indiana. For many of the members, this was their first time competing in the soil judging contest and all the contestants did very well. Members were kept busy by planning and preparing for the 2nd Annual Fall Festival and Beef Show at the Scott County Fairgrounds on October 6th and 7th. During that same weekend, Billie Goble, Kayla Goble and Jessica Richey, three of the Scottsburg FFA Greenhands, had the chance to attend the SOAR (Seeking Opportunities and Achieving Results) Conference at the Indiana FFA Leadership Center in Trafalgar, Indiana where they were introduced to the opportunities that FFA offers them.

Scottsburg FFA had 10 members attend the National FFA Convention in Indianapolis, Indiana on October 24th-27th. While at the Convention, members visited the Indianapolis Zoo, attended the Band Perry/Brantley Gilbert concert just for FFA members and took part in the different FFA sessions. Members also had the chance to learn about the process of making candles from soybeans while on the Career Success Tour to Middle David's Candles Company. Members visited the Chef's Academy on their second Career Success Tour. While at the Chef's Academy, members had the opportunity to witness the processing of a hog carcass and to create their own cookie designs. The Scottsburg FFA members took part in the FFA Rally to Fight Hunger in which they assembled meals to provide relief from hunger and malnutrition around the world.

Members did a great job of representing the Scottsburg FFA at the Annual District XI Chapter Challenge held at the Scottsburg High School on November 8th. Kevin Hardin and Lucas Brown made it to the Championship Round in the Cornhole Tournament while Samantha Lord, Heidi Burnett and Tiffany Couch competed in the Singing Bee and Saydie Boywer did her best in the Oreo Eating Contest. Levi Elliott, Emily Pfaffenbach, Samantha Dawson and Kenzie Richards did a great job of competing in the Quiz Bowl. Scottsburg FFA will have members competing in the Area II Forestry Judging contest on Thursday, November 15th in Paoli, Indiana. Members will be tested on their ability to identify forestry products and forestry management practices. The Scottsburg FFA will again host their annual Ag Olympics on Friday, November 16th in McClain Hall. This event is for our first year members, known as Greenhands, to build teamwork and leadership skills through fun activities and to learn more about the National FFA Organization from older members. Parents, as well as all members, are encouraged to attend. During the weekend of November 17th-18th, Ethan McNeely will be volunteering his time by serving as a chaperon at the FIRE (Foundations in Reaching Excellence) Conference at the Indiana FFA Leadership Center.
