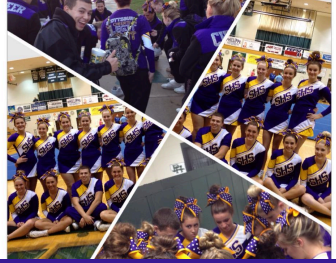

## FFA Beef Show Report

The Scottsburg FFA hosted their annual Fall Prospect Beef Show on October 19th. The show started at 11:00 AM at the Scott County Fairgrounds. This was the third successful year the Scottsburg FFA has held the show. This event was started to provide information about opportunities and educate members and the county about the beef industry in Indiana. The show gives opportunities to people to improve their skills before Beef Congress in December. This was a record-breaking year for the Beef Show. There were 59 exhibitors registered for the event, which is 11 more showmen than last year.

The show kicked off with the heifer classes which included Angus, Chi, Hereford, Shorthorn and Crossbred breeds along with one class for All Other Breeds. The steers were next on the showbill. The steer breeds included Chi, Hereford, Maine, Simmental and Crossbreds. There was one class for All Other Breeds in the steer category. Each breed winner from both heifer and steer classes won a Champion ribbon and an embroidered blanket. Overall Grand Champion Steer and Overall Grand Champion Heifer won \$250 along with a champion banner. The Reserve Grand Champion Steer and Heifer won \$100 and a reserve banner. Showmanship class winners won buckets filled with show supplies.
