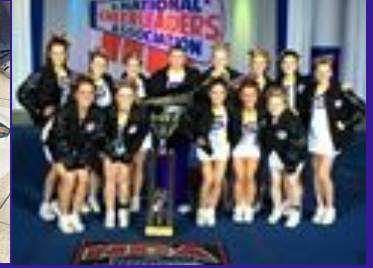

Student Council Adopt-a-School

On Mon. Feb. 24, the Student Council held their annual Adopt-a-School workshop in order to promote leadership, teamwork, and communication skills for younger councils in the community.

Even if you think you're going to take the year off, you still need to complete the FAFSA. It takes less than an hour to complete and could be worth thousands of dollars to you.
