Scottsburg won an archery match at Christian Academy of Madison by a score of 3134 to 3114.

Emily Pfaffenbach shot a blistering 289 for the honor of the highest overall score and

first place shooter for Scottsburg; Rebecka Deaton turned in a personal best score of 279 for second place; and Jon Crawford also shot his best score of 274 for third place. Brian Gullion shot a respectable 270 to come in fourth place, and Dasha Deaton rounded out the top five with a 268.
