SHS Academic Teams begin Season!

On Thursday, March 6th the Scottsburg High School Academic Team competed in the Southern Indiana Academic Conference Super Bowl at Corydon Central High School. The Scottsburg team placed first at the meet with a total of 97 questions

answered correctly in the 6 events and first place finishes in both Social Studies and Science.

The Indiana Association of School Principals sponsors the competition, which tests students in Social Studies, Math, English, Science and Fine Arts. Scottsburg High School has won the state titles in both Science (2013) and English (2012) in the past two years.

Scottsburg will again compete at Corydon Central High School on March 18th, and the state qualifier at Austin High School on April 22nd.
