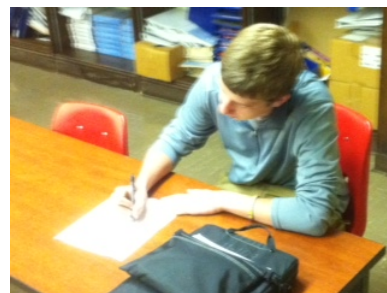

## SHS Stats...

SHS recently was made aware of the Indiana College Readiness Report. SHS exceeded the State average of graduates that attended Indiana Public

Colleges and Universities! This does not track private colleges nor out of state institutions. This information also informs us of areas that we could improve such as increasing our rigor in our core subject areas to cut down on remediation by colleges. We are thrilled that our State Colleges and

Universities are accepting more and more of our graduates. Almost half of the class of 2010 (the most recent data) were accepted at State Colleges and Universities. When you include private and out of state colleges, more than half of SHS graduates attend college the first year after leaving SHS!

The top two choices of SHS Students in 2010 for Public Colleges were Ivy Tech Community College and Indiana University Southeast. These were followed by University of Southern Indiana and Purdue University.
