## Concert Percussion Program Achieves National Recognition

The Scottsburg High School Concert Percussion Ensemble recently competed at the WGI (Winter Guard International) World Percussion Championships in Dayton, OH on April 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup>. The group came away ranked 9<sup>th</sup> in the nation. Band directors Doug Goodwin and Tim Johnston direct the concert percussion ensemble. Their staff includes Band of Warrior's alumni Mason Neace, Dalton McCleery, Adam Comer, and U of L student Chris Cutshall. "Our goal was to be competitive and have the best run possible, and represent our school and community well," stated director Doug Goodwin. "We knew how difficult it would be to make it into finals." It was the group's first time competing on the national level.

The WGI World Percussion championships draw in over 170 percussion ensembles from across US, Japan, China, and other countries. They are split up into 8 different classes and ensemble types for competition. We were entered into the Scholastic Open Class, which featured US schools of all sizes. After a 4-hour wait, they learned that they were named as a national finalist. Senior Randi Diehl stated, "It was great to see all of the work that has been put in over the last 3 years finally pay off." The group has only existed for a short amount of time, and has quickly grown to national acclaim.

The ensemble's music, Rachmaninoff's Piano Concerto No. 2, featured sophomore Jon Treadway and freshman Josiah Croasdell on the piano. The program was set up as a piano duel, which then was imitated within the percussion ensemble. We recently receive an email of congratulations from WGI Hall of Fame member Jay Webb who is the band director at Avon High School, a 3 time BOA National Champion. He stated, "Congratulations on a great season! The kids were musical and well rehearsed. The program had a cool idea and high level of entertainment. Tell the members that I was quite impressed!"

The Scott County School District #2 Board of Education voted this month to begin junior varsity football and to continue football at the middle school.

This opportunity is available to SHS & SMS students. Over sixty students have already begun conditioning and preparing for the fall season. We want to thank SHS Swim Coach Jason Carter and Matt Mihalik for volunteering their time for this program until a coach is named for our Warriors!
