Dairy Judging

Scottsburg FFA competed in two competitions on Thursday, April 4. They competed in the Area II Livestock and Area II Dairy Judging CDE competitions. The Dairy Cattle Evaluation and Management CDE is a competitive event that tests the student's ability to select and manage quality dairy cattle. The Dairy Judging CDE contest took place at the Nierman Dairy Farm in Brownstown, Indiana. The members of the Scottsburg FFA Dairy Judging teams consisted of Samantha Brown, Caitlin Crumes, Kevin Jentzen, Heidi Burnett, Kailey Barrett and Kelsie Eldridge. Livestock Judging

The Livestock Judging CDE is a competitive event that tests the student's ability to select and evaluate livestock which includes beef, sheep, swine and goats. The Area II Livestock Judging contest took place at the United Producers Facility in Little York, Indiana. The members of the Scottsburg FFA Livestock Judging teams were Ethan McNeely, Kirk Hardin, Kevin Hardin, Kyle Richey, Tyler Mills, Nick Robbins and Jesse Kallenbach. The team consisting of Ethan McNeely, Kirk Hardin, Kevin Hardin and Kyle Richey placed third as a team which has qualified them to compete at the State Livestock Judging CDE on May 18th, 2013. Scottsburg FFA also had Ethan McNeely placed first as an individual for the third year in a row!



Horse Judging

On April 13th, Scottsburg FFA had four members compete in the Area II Horse and Pony Judging CDE contest at the Scott County Fairgrounds. The Horse Evaluation CDE is a competitive event that tests the student's ability to select and evaluate horses with both halter and performance classes. The Scottsburg FFA team consisted of Anna Hall, Tyler Mills, Drake Whobrey and Cody Newsome. The team placed third overall and Tyler Mills placed 5th as an individual. The team has qualified for the State Horse Judging Contest on May 4th, 2013.

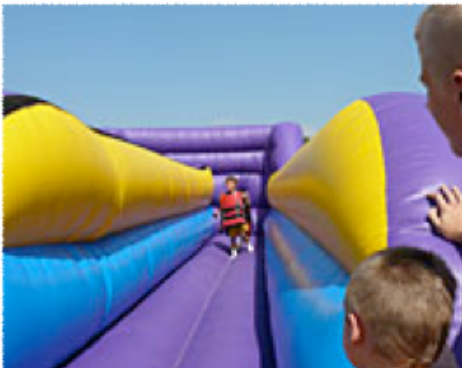

Dear Parent,

With the highest level of support from Governor Mike Pence, representatives from the Indiana State Police Department have contacted our school corporation, as well as many other school corporations across Indiana, and requested permission to have State Troopers, on a random basis, walk the halls during school hours. The State Police have also offered to perform programs about general safety and various state laws as time permits during regular school hours.

Our school was not chosen as a result of any study, safety concern, or worry, related to any pre-existing safety problem. This is part of a state-wide initiative by the Indiana State Police to increase the visibility of law enforcement in Indiana schools. The benefit of this is two-fold; an added level of security for our children and the opportunity for the students to interact with police officers in a positive learning environment. Please keep this in mind as you may see State Police cars in the school parking lots and your children may tell you about State Troopers walking the hallways of their school.

In closing, the purpose of this letter is merely to inform parents and guardians of our students about the initiative of the Indiana State Police to have a more visible presence in schools across Indiana. Our school has welcomed the presence of our local state troopers, who are part of our community, and view this as an opportunity to enhance the safety of our existing school safety plan.
