Academic Teams Advance

Congratulations go out to both the SHS Social Studies and Science Academic teams for advancing to the State Finals.

The Social Studies team dominated at the qualifier on Tuesday, scoring 21 points and beating all teams, in all divisions. Team members are Kaleb Mount, Haley Beckwith, Evan Howser, Abigail Walsh and AJ Hunger. They are coached by Shannon Mount. The first year coach is thrilled with their undefeated streak in three contests so far. "I'm really not the leading authority on Social Studies, but I am highly competitive! I kept setting higher and higher study standards and the team kept meeting these expectations. The kids did all the hard work; they deserve all the credit. Hard work and time invested really paid off. I'm so proud."

This makes the second consecutive state qualification for the Science Team, coached by Robert Deirth. The team made the finals after a disputed question and then winning the tie-breaker. Mr. Deirth said, "We knew we had the ability to be at the State Finals again. Although it was not our best performance, we are pleased to be back in the finals and to be able to compete for a second State Championship." The team includes John Cleveland, Nick Shelton, Brian Gullion, Noah Burns and Jacob Cook. The teams head to Purdue for the Academic Super Bowl on May 10, 2014.
