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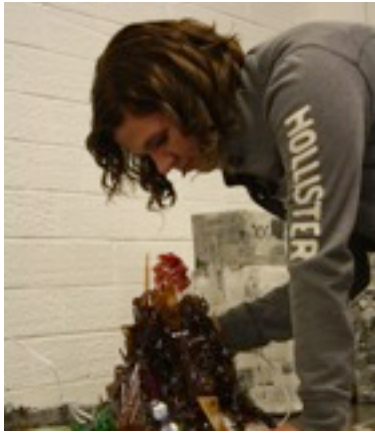

## SHS Career Internship Class

The pilot class of the professional career internship has been implemented this semester with three HSTW students. These students are preparing for college and are taking the class to help develop it, while also having a venue to discuss and research careers. Since the goal of this class is to empower students with authentic experiences to test current career choices or explore potential interest in various careers, this first class is helping this goal become a reality. Next year New Tech will also implement this class as part of its model with the first senior class.

This class has about 6 weeks of instructional time to prepare them for experiences in the workplace. Students then are expected to research information on future job markets and search for potential placements. The student, along with the teacher then approaches these potential community placements to explain the program and to see if there is a position that would help students clarify the career they may be exploring. Students this year understand this is a pilot, so strengths and weaknesses need to be assessed throughout the pilot semester.

Currently, the students are involved at Farm Credit Services and Mid America Science Park for a couple of days a week. All students currently are involved in projects for these groups. On days they are in the classroom informal discussions are held on college success and observations from the field among other relevant topics that may arise. Students are encouraged to keep a journal or blog of their experience. Their formal placement will end in mid May, however one of the students has been asked to be part of a summer internship. From May until the end of the year the students will discuss ways to procure internships to increase successful career opportunities after college.
