Winter Percussion wins Mid-South Regional!

The Scottsburg Concert Percussion ensemble finished in 1st place at the WGI Mid-South Percussion Championships at Western Kentucky University on Sunday March 23rd. We feel very blessed to represent the City of Scottsburg, our School, and the state of Indiana at this national competition. WGI, Winter Guard International, is the international sanctioning body for winter guards and winter percussion units. Schools competed in many different classes and represented a large geographical area from many states including Florida, Georgia, South Carolina, Kentucky, Tennessee, North Carolina, Alabama, Louisiana, Mississippi, Missouri,

Illinois, Ohio, and Michigan. Scottsburg was the only high school to represent Indiana at this event.

Under the direction of Assistant Band Director Doug Goodwin, the Scottsburg Concert Percussion program is only in its 3rd year of existence. The program has risen very quickly to gain national attention in this competitive arena. This is the first time that any of the Scottsburg band's programs has won a WGI competition of this size. We set a school record this weekend, by nearly breaking the 90 point barrier, with a score of 89.5!

The Scottsburg Concert Percussion Program will end their season at the WGI World Percussion Championships in Dayton, OH on April 10th and 11th. We are very excited about competing in this prestigious competition for the first time, said director Doug Goodwin. The group's goal is to have the best performance possible and let the judges sort out the rest. Bringing home a world championship would be great, but introducing the city and Scottsburg High School to the world means a lot to our students!
