## Academic Teams continue Streak!

Congratulations to the SHS Academic Teams for continuing a streak of state championships! SHS sent two teams to the state academic competition on the campus of Purdue University this past weekend.

Our defending champions the science academic squad performed extremely well again this year. They scored 22 out of 25 possible points. This is a score that will usually result in winning the championship most years. However, they faced

extremely tough competition and finished 4th in the state. This team had an amazing streak going undefeated for almost two straight years.

Our social studies team qualified for the first time in many years. The team was made up of one senior, two juniors and two sophomores. They scored a state high 23 out of 25. They not only won their class title, but also defeated perennial power Penn High School. They ended Penn's five year run as overall state champions in all classes.

This is the third straight academic state championships for SHS. We are proud of our students and sponsors for preparing our young people to compete at the highest levels.

The State NASP awarded ten seniors scholarship money for a total of \$5,000. Jordanne has been a member of the school's archery team for three years, a sport in which she has excelled.

She has competed at the State Tournament all three years, and went to the National Competition two years.

The archery team competed in the National Tournament held May 9-11 in Louisville, KY. Top archers for SHS were Emily Pfaffenbach, John Cleveland and Curt Wilson who all scored 280 out of a possible 300 points.

The winner had to be determined by the number of arrows shot into the 10 ring. Emily had 16 tens, John had 15 and Curt had 13 tens.

Jairus Tyree and Dasha Deaton finished 4th and 5th with scores of 275 and 272. The team scored 3163 points which placed them 113 out of 164 High Schools across the nation.
