This year, kids can receive a free, nutritious lunch at any of the several sites located throughout the county. Lunches will be served in Austin at The Hickory Lakes Mobile Village from 12:00 to 12:30 and at Austin Community Park from 12:40-1:00. In Scottsburg, lunches will be served at Beechwood Park, World Outreach Church, and the YMCA.

Meals will be served from 12:00-12:30 at all three locations. A free lunch will also be provided to children in Lexington and Vienna. A bus will park at the Lexington Town Square from 1:00-1:30. Vienna Baptist Church is running a free, all-day summer program, for children K-12 and will also serve lunch at 12:00.

Program runs Monday-Friday during the summer, except the 4th of July. Austin Sites begin June 2 and Scottsburg/Vienna/Lexington begin June 9. Please help us spread the word to families in our county.
