Mrs. Tammy Davis volunteered her time this past Saturday to help her students to become CPR certified. SHS is the ONLY school in the state of Indiana that offers a dual credit course for Emergency Medical Technician.

Students earn college credit through Vincennes University while working on their state certification to obtain an EMT license. Students are required to have Anatomy as a prerequisite. They are also required to have observation hours over the year with EMS and the Scott County Emergency Room.

Students that complete the course may then take the test for their license. This course saves our students and their parents money as there is no charge for this course as a student.
