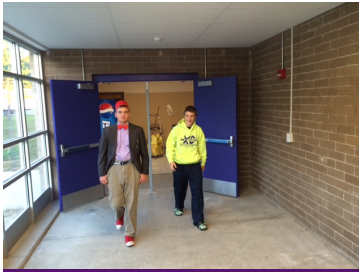

The SHS girls golf team placed 3rd at the Madison Sectional held at Sunrise Golf Course this past Saturday allowing them the opportunity to advance to the IHSAA Golf Regional. 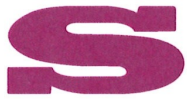
Prosser Opportunities
