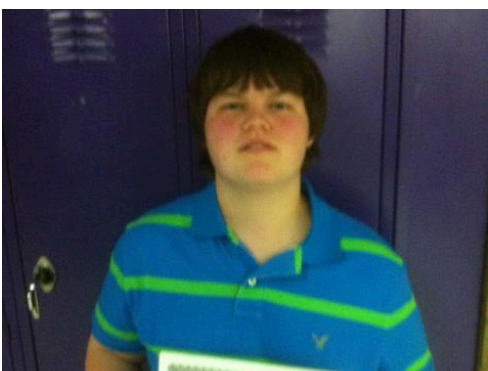

Several different animals, including this bald eagle, made an appearance as part of the Animal unit she covered in both her Biology and Spanish classes. The Spanish students learned vocabulary and the Biology students studied behavior and classification.

As an Interpretive Naturalist at Hardy Lake, Mrs. Davis was able to display a variety of animals including mice, snakes, rabbits, turtles, an owl, a falcon, and the eagle. The students also had the opportunity to see several animal hides including buffalo, elk, caribou, lynx, and kangaroo.
