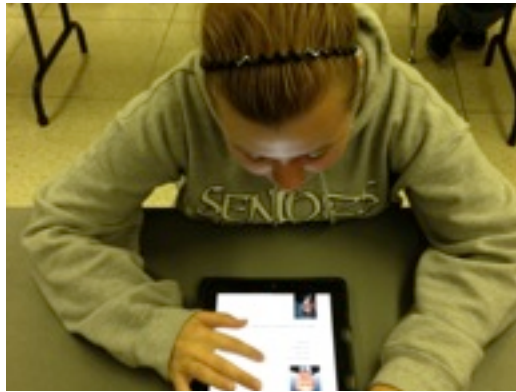

## Seniors Test I pads

Students in Mr. Routt's government class have begun using iPads this semester. The Gary W. Moenter Media Center purchased twenty iPads at the start of the school year. In an attempt to pilot the differences between using an iPad and Macbook at the high school, two senior government classes have been using the iPads in their class.

Some of the applications and resources being used on the iPad include Evernote, Google Docs, Haiku Deck, and iTunes U. Here is a brief description of these applications:

Evernote allows us to collect information from anywhere and compile it into a single place that is accessible from multiple platforms, including phones, tablets, and computers. This application has been a great asset in collaboration in the classroom.

Google Docs is a web based platform that allows us to create documents, spreadsheets, and presentations.

This is an internet based solution that allows access from any device or computer that has an internet connection. Students have been turning their assignments in through Google Docs helping us to be more eco-friendly.

Haiku Deck is an innovative application for students to create and to deliver presentations to the class. It is an amazing tool that encourages our students to master content and to tell a better story for presentations.

While our HSTW program is actively using My Big Campus as our content delivery platform, students in this class have been using iTunes U to gain a digital experience that will be more readily available in a college environment. iTunes U allows teachers to post and to manage digital curriculum that students can easily access from the iPad.

Most students seem excited about the changes and opportunities to work from a digital platform. Mr. Routt appreciates the opportunity to help students master twenty-first century technology skills and to receive quality digital work from the students. Brittany G'Fellers, a senior, reports that she has quicker access to data and that she enjoys ubiquitous access to her assignments from multiple devices because they are saved in the cloud.

Scottsburg High School is a front-runner in the movement to a digital curriculum. We are excited about preparing our students for their futures by capitalizing on cutting-edge educational resources and methods.



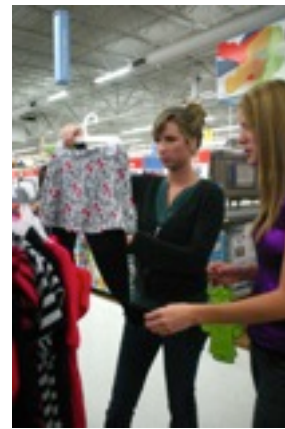
## Archery Club Hits the Target
